Family Shelter I and II is a new emergency shelter complex on the west side of the Century Villages at Cabrillo campus. In partnership with Catholic Charities of Los Angeles, the new facilities will replace and expand the existing Elizabeth Ann Seton Residence which has operated at CVC since 1998. Since inception, the Elizabeth Ann Seton Residence has served more than 2,000 families.


The new shelter complex will provide a total of 14 shelter units for families in need, including single and two parent families, men, and children over the age of 12. The shelter complex also provides shared recreational play space, a community room, counseling offices, a commercial kitchen, and dining facilities.
